Southwest Medical University was formally established as Southern Sichuan Doctors' School in the year 1951. The school was then renamed as Luzhou Specialist School of Medicine in 1958. The school was granted an authority to award Bachelor s degrees in 1978 and its name then changed to Luzhou Medical College. Luzhou Medical College was given an authority to rename itself to Sichuan Medical College in 2015 which was protested by West China Medical Center of Sichuan University as this name was quite similar to its former names. Finally, the school was renamed to Southwest Medical University in 2016. Zhongshan campus and Chengbei campus are the two campuses of Southwest Medical University. The university has 5 non-subordinating hospitals along with 39 teaching hospitals that nearly have a total bed-count of 15,500.
