China Three Gorges University or CTGU is a public comprehensive university located in Xiling District, near to the Xiling Gorge, one of the Three Gorges. Hence it got its name. The university, as a result of merger of Hubei Sanxia University, University of Hydraulic and Electric Engineering at Yichang and a medical college founded in 1946 was established in June 2000. China Three Georges University or CTGU has 30 teaching units. As of 2012, the university has enrolled over 24,000 full time understudies, 2,336 postgraduate students and 1,048 international students. The university has key laboratories at the provincial and state level, doctoral and master degree programs. The libraries of CTGU consists of over 2,00,000 volumes.
